| Eastern/Orthodox Easter | Sunday, April 16 th | Same as Roman/Western Easter, but heavier 25-50lbs (11-23kg) 35-40lbs (16-18kg) optimal |
| Ramadan | March 22 nd – April 20 th | Weaned, milk teeth Males (intact or castrated) and females under 12 months old Overly fat kids not desired Optimal weight: 60lbs (27kg), 45-120lb (20-54kg) accepted |
| Eid al-Fitr (Feast of the Breaking of the Fast) | Friday, April 21 st | Same as for Ramadan |
| Cinco de Mayo | Friday, May 5 th | Milk-fed kids, "Cabrito", 20-35lbs (9-15kg) Larger animals for goat stew, "seco de chivo" |
| Eid al-Adha (Feast of the Sacrifice) | Wednesday, June 28 th | Prefer yearlings (animals with one set of adult teeth) Blemish-free (no broken horns, no open wounds, no torn ears, no physical unsoundness) Prefer males to be intact, but would accept castrated males if no wound from the castration Large kids 60 - 100 lbs also in demand |
| Muharramm/Hajra (Islamic New Year) | Tuesday, July 18 th | No preferred weight Animals should appear healthy |
